



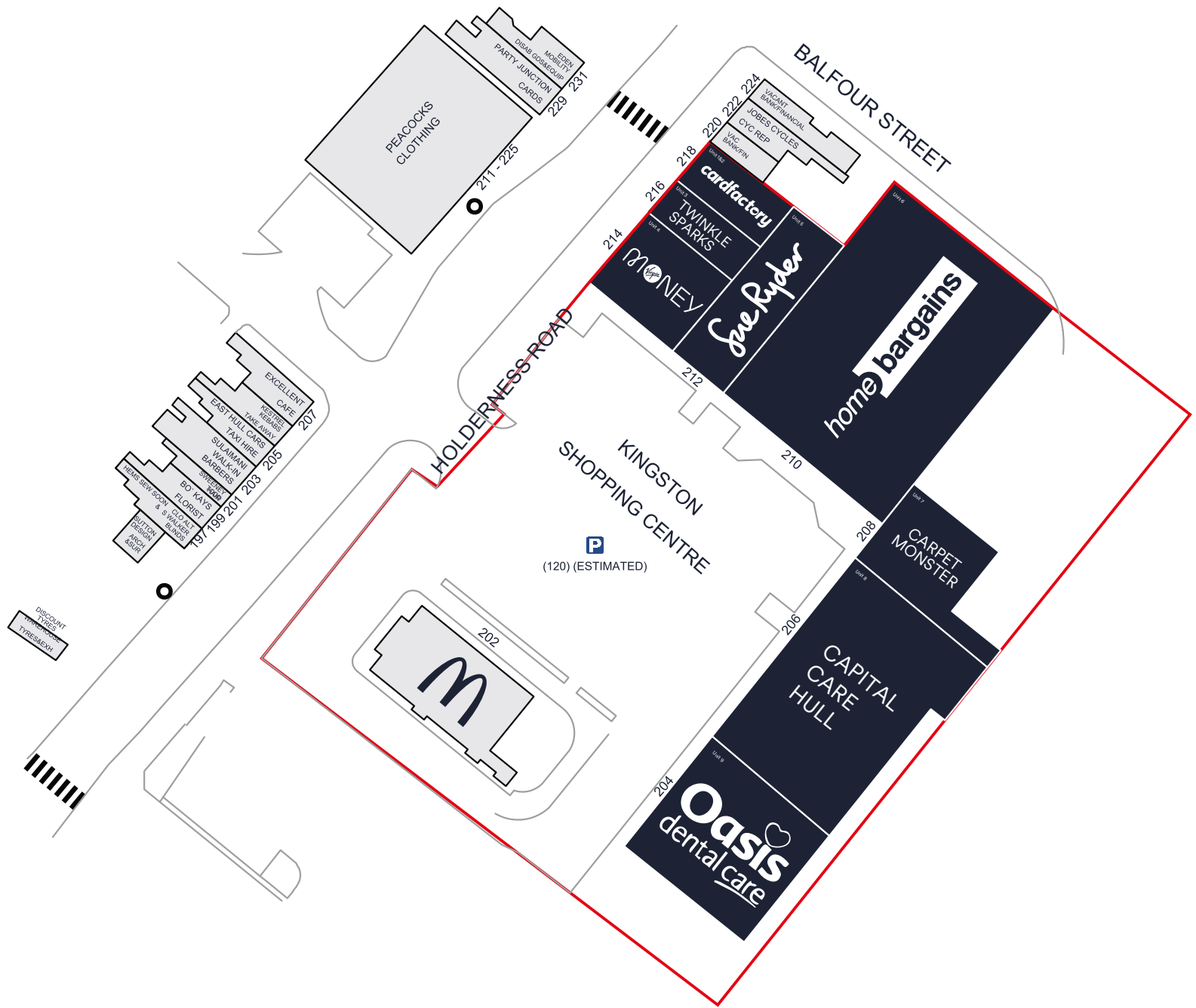

## DESCRIPTION

M Park Kingston is a modern, suburban development in Hull situated on Holderness Road which is one of the main arterial routes into the city centre.

The scheme comprises a terrace of 8 retail units built around a car park offering approximately 120 free spaces with occupiers including Card Factory Virgin Money, Home Bargains, Oasis Dental Care, Sue Ryder and McDonald's.

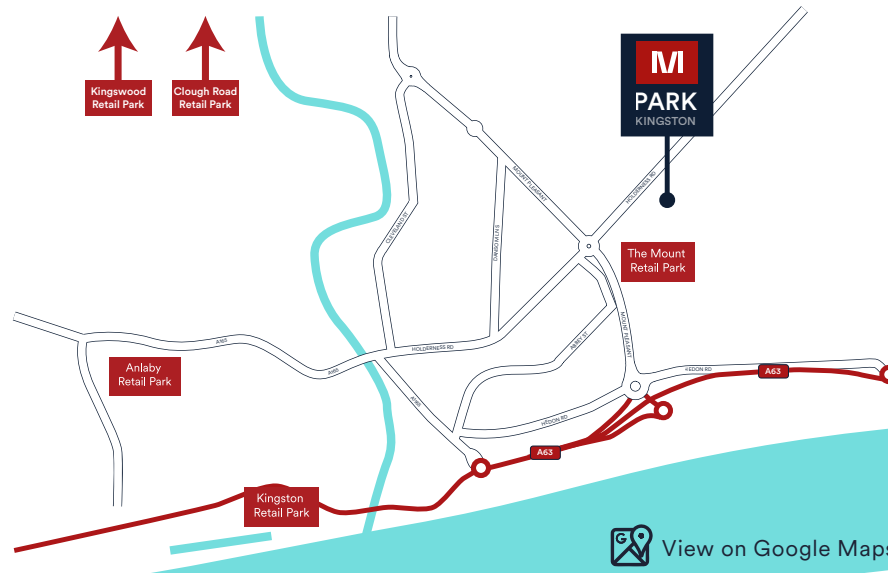
